GETTING THERE.

NATIONAL RAIL - The nearest national rail stations are

Elephant & Castle or London Bridge which is easier if travelling from the Croydon area. Group (3+) Travel tickets can reduce the costs for those traveling from outside the Freedom Pass area if you do not have a Senior Railcard.

UNDERGROUND - The nearest underground stations are Kennington - Circle, District or Piccadilly lines. Travelcard Zone 1 Elephant & Castle - Northern or Bakerloo lines. Travelcard Zones 1 & 2. (E & C has 2 exits) You can walk from both underground stations to the museum.

BUS – Many buses go to Elephant & Castle

To catch the **133** bus from London Bridge station, exit on to Tooley Street, turn left and walk up to the top. Turn right on to Borough High Street and catch the 133 bus to Streatham opposite the Barrow Boy & Banker pub and alight at the **Newington Butts** bus stop. This is after the Elephant & Castle (Newington Causeway) and Elephant & Castle Station stops. Renfrew Road is off Kennington Lane (A3204)

The nearest bus stop to the museum is Renfrew Road on the **196** bus route from Elephant & Castle to Norwood Junction.

The roads in this area can be very busy so please use the designated crossings.

To find alternative ways of getting there from your area go to the Transport for London website and plan a journey.
